

Drawing-Grade 2-5,Limit 12 Students- 2 week course.

Course Fee:\$110 MES ART ROOM-Ms. Trumpbour

If your child loves to draw, they will love this course. Students will learn about different drawing techniques. They will explore contour lines and shading. There will be many fun projects your child will be proud of.

Knitting-Grade 3-8,Limit 10 Students- Must attend at least 3 of 4 weeks.

Course Fee:\$175, Additional week \$25 MES ART ROOM-Ms. Trumpbour

Knitting is an art form which has been handed down from generation to generation. Knitting is a multi-faceted like-skill which utilizes reading, math, science, art, and history. Many educational studies have shown that knitting has helped increase math and reading skills. The student will learn how to read patterns, select yarn, and perform basic knit and purl techniques. Ms. Trumpbour will increase the enthusiasm of the student by taking a field trip to the local yarn shop where students will learn about different yarns and the variety of patterns available.

Painting-Grade 2-5,Limit 12 Students- 2 week course.

Course Fee:\$110 MES ART ROOM-Ms. Trumpbour

Painting is an interactive, ever-changing form of expression. Students will use different painting techniques. Students will also explore different lines, textures, shapes, and colors to produce the painting. Through this course, students will also acquire knowledge of art history, as an integral part of understanding painting.

Printmaking-Grade 2-5,Limit 10 Students- 2 week course.

Course Fee:\$110 MES ART ROOM-Ms. Trumpbour

Traditional printmaking techniques fall into four categories: relief, intaglio, stenciling, and planographic. We will be using a variety of methods that have been used and developed through the centuries. This will be a fun class that students will learn so much in a short time. Each student will walk away with frameable pieces.

Silly Monsters-Grade 3-4 & Grade 5-8, Limit 12 Students(each session)- 2 week course.

Course Fee:\$120 MES ART ROOM-Ms. Trumpbour

By using sculpture materials, children will create their own silly monster as a “pet!” Using their silly monster they will then creatively write a story, will will be attractively presented in book form.

Creative Writing- Grade 3-5 & 6-8-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course, 2 weeks offered.

Course Fee:\$55/week MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

This course is an open ended writing workshop that will engage students imaginations while exposing them to the adventures of creative writing.

Scrapbooking- Grade 3-5 & 6-8-Limit 10 Students-2 week course.

Course Fee:\$115 MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

This is a foundational course for learning the techniques and purpose of creative scrapbooking.

Science Lab Workshop- Grade 4-5-Limit 10 Students 1 week course, 2 weeks offered. *Course Fee:\$55/week MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron*

This course is designed as a science lab that focuses on hands-on activities that enhances critical thinking and cognitive ability.

Super Scientist- Grade 2-3-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course, 2 weeks offered.

Course Fee:\$55/week MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

This course is a science workshop that focuses on hands-on activities.

Origami- Grade 3-4-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course.

Course Fee:\$55 MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

This course is designed for beginners interested in creating flat pieces of paper into 3-Dimensional shapes.

Arts and Crafts Workshop- Grade 2-3-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course.

Course Fee:\$ 60 MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

Come have fun exploring art and craft projects and discover your creativity! Students' work may include tile mosaics, drawing, painting, paper maché, collage, felt craft project, sculpture, or creative projects using recycled materials.

Jewelry Making- Grade 2-3-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course.

Course Fee:\$60 MES ROOM #108-Ms. Gawron

This course is designed to introduce students to the basics of jewelry making.

Baking Basics- Grade 6-8,Limit 12 Students- 2 week course.

Course Fee:\$140, This course is held at MHS, HOME EC ROOM.-Ms. Morris

Students will be exposed to the basics of measuring and preparing baked goods such as cookies, brownies, pizza, and bread.(Students with food allergies should avoid food classes.)

Kids in the Kitchen- Grade 5-8, Limit 12 Students- 1 week course.

Course Fee:\$80 This course is held at MHS,HOME EC ROOM.-Ms. Morris

Students will learn basic cooking techniques to prepare dishes like spaghetti & meatballs, fried rice, and chicken panini's. Techniques include stir-frying, grilling, baking, and boiling. (Students with food allergies should avoid food classes.)

Fun With Fashion- Grade 6-8, Limit 12 Students- 1 week course

Course Fee:\$85 This course is held at MHS,HOME EC ROOM.-Ms. Morris

Students will become acquainted with fashion terminology and styles. Daily projects will incorporate the use of fabrics and various materials(beads, trim, ect.) to create their own designs!

Folktales and Fairy Tales- Grade 1-3-Limit 10 Students- 1 week course.

Read some of the classics. Create crafts and write a tale of your own. Work on reading fluency with Reader's Theater scripts.

Banking for Beginners- Grade 4-5-Limit 10 Students-1 week course.

Learn the basics, how to write a check and balance a checkbook. Learn about budgeting. Will you be able to afford your wants after paying for your needs?

Getting Ready for 1st Grade Reading-Grade 1-Limit 12 Students-1 week course, 4 weeks offered

Getting Ready for 1st Grade Math-Grade 1-Limit 12 Students- 1 week course, 4 weeks offered

*Review numbers and counting sequence *Compare numbers *Addition and subtraction *Place value *Shapes * Group activities.

Forensic Files/CSI- Grades 4,5,6,7-Limit 15 Students- 1 week course, 3 Hour class

Students will have the exciting opportunity to explore the science behind Crime Scene Investigation. Upon entering the class, students will be presented with a crime scene. Each day a new investigative technique will be presented and students will work in teams to solve the mystery! On the last day, students will hold a mock trial to determine the guilt or innocence of the suspect! (DNA, fingerprinting, lip analysis, just to name a few!)

Alphabet Soup-Grade K- Limit 10 Students- 1 week course, 2 weeks offered.

Introduction and review of letters and sounds. Hands on activities and games helping with letters, names, sounds and order.

Fun With Numbers- Grade K- 1-Limit 10 Students,1 week course, 2 weeks offered.

Introduction and review of numbers 0-20. Hands on activities and games. Practice counting and writing numbers.

Million Dollar Project- Grade 4-6-Limit 10 Students-1 week course.

Scrapbooking Mania-Grade 4-8-Limit 10 Students-1 week course.

English Enrichment-Grade K-3,4-5,6-8- 2 week course.

Students will explore topics in Science and Social Studies using English Literacy skills.(Reading, writing, listening, speaking) This is an ESL class.

Summer Band-Grade 5-8- 4 week course.

Jazz Band- Grade 5-8- 4 week course.

This class is for band students with some experience. The group will play jazz and rock music and will also learn the basics of improvisation. This class is where the students can “let loose” and show their stuff!

Beginning Guitar/Beginning Piano- Grade 5-8-Limit 12 Students- 4 week course.

Sharpening Math Skills-Grade 4-5- 1 week course- 2 weeks offered

Students will review key concepts through differentiated and hands-on learning activities/games. Great for enhancing problem-solving skills and preparing with all the essentials necessary for middle school.

Math Workshop-Grade 2-3- 1 week course-2 weeks offered

Students will review a get ahead in math by using interactive and fun math activities. A great refresher to keep skills intact and a great look ahead to prepare for the upcoming school year.

Introduction to Strings-Violin & Cello-Grade 4-5 & 6-8- 1 week course

This is a one hour class where students can explore either violin or cello. Students will learn basic

music notation, proper bow hold and a modified “Suzuki “style for this one week introduction. Violins and Cellos can be rented through MMDA and the Violin Doctor of Allenwood NJ.

Music for Little Mozart’s- Grade K-2- 1 week course

Songwriting and Vocal Studio- Grade 4-5 & 6-7-1 week course

Group Ukulele -Grade 3-6- 1 week course

This class is intended for the true beginning musician. Classes will start with the fundamentals, students will play simple chords and melodies. We’ll work on strumming simple songs both popular and traditional music. Class members will learn to play songs in folk, rock and Hawaiian styles. Also covered: tuning, ukulele care, and basic strums. No prerequisites, but a ukulele is required. Uke can be purchased at MMDA
